QUICK TIPS

- Identify a team leader. The team leader will write the answer down and have final say with all answers.
- Collaborate: your table is your team and as a team you provide ONE answer per question.
- Hold up answer sheets after each round in a timely manner.

QUESTIONS

- There are 4 rounds of questions with 4 questions in each round plus 4 bonus questions, 1 halftime question, and 1 final question. There are a total of 22 questions.
- 90 seconds for questions and bonuses / 3 minutes for halftime question and for final question
- All questions are read out loud by the emcee and will appear on screen.
- Answers will be shared after each round of questions. All spellings must be close to be given points.
- After the trivia question is read, teams will write their answer and point value down.

SCORING

- In each round of 4 questions, teams **MUST** bet 2, 4, 6, or 8 points depending on how confident they are of the answer.
- Use each number **ONLY** one time per round of questions.

RUNNERS

- Volunteer assigned to your table.
- Answers questions about the game.
- Collects your answers after each round to bring them to the judges.

NOT ALLOWED

- Do not shout out the answers.
- Do not use anything that can be used to cheat (phones, tablets, computers, reference materials, etc.)
- Any person who cheats will cause the team to lose 10 points.
- Do not ask the judges for team standings. You will be updated 2 times during the game.
- No challenges – Judge rulings are final.

Study Guide Sample Questions:

These are actual trivia questions from past trivia games. Review them to understand the types of questions that will be asked on February 18th.

- 1) After 25 years of slow and painful reforms, this Southeast Asian country is on track to achieve annual growth rates of 7% to 10% over the next 10 years. Call centers are vital to this economy and helped create 400,000 jobs. This country has overtaken India as the call center capital of the world. Name this country. - **Answer: The Philippines**
- 2) Greenland is the world's largest island. Prior to gaining its autonomy as a dependent territory in 1979, Greenland was a province of what country? - **Answer: Denmark.**
- 3) From a geological perspective, the Arabian Peninsula is considered a subcontinent of Asia. Excluding the southern parts of Iraq and Jordan, name 4 of the 7 countries that make up the Arabian Peninsula. - **Answer: Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates (UAE), and Yemen.**
- 4) This Spanish architect nicknamed "God's Architect", who is best known as a practitioner of Catalan Modernism, has had 7 of his works declared World Heritage Sites by UNESCO. Name this architect. (first and last name) - **Answer: Antoni Gaudi.**

Bonus Sample Questions:

- 1) The United Nations (UN) is an intergovernmental organization that promotes international co-operation. It served as a replacement for the ineffective League of Nations and was established on October 24, 1945 by Franklin D. Roosevelt following World War II in order to prevent another such conflict. Currently, how many active member states make up the United Nations? - **Answer: 193**
- 2) It might come as a surprise, but McDonalds is the world's SECOND largest fast food chain based on number of locations. McDonalds serves over 68 million customers in over 35,000 locations DAILY. In how many countries does McDonalds have locations? - **Answer: 119 Countries**
- 3) As of December 31, 2015, what is the city population of Istanbul? - **Answer: 14,025,646 people**
- 4) How many total goals were scored in the 2014 World Cup Brazil competitions? - **Answer: 171.**
